### **KOSOVO** | Fiscal Emergency Package

On March 30, 2020, the Government of the Republic of Kosovo issued Decision no. 01/19 on the **Fiscal Emergency Package** approving measures intended for those affected by governmental measures to prevent the spread of Covid-19, specifically for beneficiaries of social programs from the state, employees self-employed, as well as private and public companies.

It should be noted that the criteria, conditions, method of implementation and any other specifications necessary for the implementation of the measures will be decided by the Minister of Finance.

Below we have listed measures that affect businesses:

- I. The Government will provide financial support to companies facing financial difficulty as a result of decline in their activity, in the following manner:
  - a. by covering of expenditures for the monthly salaries in the amount of one hundred seventy Euros (EUR 170) for April and May, up to the amount of forty-one million Euros (EUR 41,000,000.00);
  - b. by providing rent subsidy up to fifty percent (50%) of the rent value for small and medium enterprises for April and May, up to the amount of twelve million Euros (EUR 12,000,000.00) and
  - c. by covering the value of pension contributions for amount specified in a. for April and May, up to the amount of eight million Euros (EUR 8,000,000.00).
- II. The Government will provide interest-free loans to publicly-owned enterprises facing financial difficulties due to the public health emergency situation, aiming to ensure their temporary liquidity, with maturity period until 31.12.2020 and financial liquidity for business organization authorized to provide basic services, with the return period until 31.12.2020 up to the amount of twenty million Euros (EUR 20,000,000.00);
- III. The Government will provide financial liquidity for: Micro-enterprises and the self-employed through certain programs of the Kosovo Credit Guarantee Fund, in the amount of ten thousand (EUR 10,000) Euros

- for a period of 24 months, up to the amount of fifteen million Euros (EUR 15,000,000.00);
- IV. The Government will provide financial support to business organizations registering employees with at least one (1) year employment contract during the period of public health emergency situation, with one hundred and thirty Euros (EUR 130) for the following two months after registration of the employee, up to the amount of six million Euros (EUR 6,000,000.00);
- V. After the end of the public health emergency situation, the Government will provide support to exporters in Kosovo in the total amount of ten million Euros (EUR 10, 000 000.00).
